Airport Commission:

The next Airport Commission meeting will be on Wednesday, the 9th of September in the Airport Terminal Building beginning at 6:00 PM. Please notify us in advance if you need any special arrangements.

- Commissioner Brian Bellerose has resigned and is moving out of state. He will be greatly missed at the ATC as well as by the Commission!
- Commissioner Dick McColley's term limits have been reached and he will be required to step down from the Commission for one term.
- Commissioner Chris Ireland will not seek another Commission term.
- Commissioner Rob Harnage has resigned from the Commission.

Airfield Projects:

The Taxiway Juliet Realignment and Runway 12/30 Overlay projects are under way. These projects will continue until the end of December, 2009. ALWAYS check NOTAM's before taxiing around the airfield.

Self Serve 100LL at the Sierra Vista Municipal Airport:

Specifications have been prepared and are out for quotes to qualified companies to provide a self-contained, self-serve 100LL Avgas fuel system for the Airport. The system will hold 5,000 gallons of Avgas, be available 24/7, and accept most major credit cards. And for those who don't want to fill their own aircraft, the existing service will still be available. Keep posted for updates!

Airfield Closed Areas:

There seems to be some confusion about the closed areas around the airfield. Here is a partial list of closed areas:

1. Juliet Taxiway is closed.
2. Kilo Taxiway is closed.
3. Delta Taxiway is closed from the north side of Runway 08/26 to the north.
4. The Large Aircraft Ramp west of the access road is closed.
5. Runway 12/30 is closed.

The only access to and from the City side of the airport is Taxiway Golf. There will be a map of the airfield and all closed areas posted in the Pilot Lounge. It is your responsibility to check NOTAM's before your flight.
